Garden Waste

The gardeners amongst you are probably knee deep in seed catalogues and garden layout plans preparing for the flowering season. Although most people are true Tadley citizens and ensure that their garden waste is responsibly disposed of, there are still a few who fly tip.

Please remember that putting grass cuttings, or indeed any other unwanted garden refuse, under hedgerows, shrubs or in any other public garden space, is fly tipping and you could be fined if caught.

If you do not wish to, or cannot get to the Wade Road refuse site, you can arrange with Basingstoke & Deane Borough Council to use their garden waste collection service. Just ring them on 01256 844844 and arrange to receive the collection bags, the quantity is up to you.

Please don't take the chance of ruining your Summer by risking a fine. Cut it, prune it, mow it, BAG IT and dispose of it responsibly. Thank you.
