
Committee meetings are held via Zoom and Full Council meetings are held in the Town Council offices and both start at 7.30pm.

Council Tax

At the Full Council meeting held on 6 January 2025, Tadley Town Council agreed to set the precept at £216,906. This is an increase on last year which was £213,129. This means each band D household in Tadley will pay £50.93 for the services provided by the Town Council in the year 2025/26, an increase of 67p per year.
