# **Recreation & Leisure**

Replaced the entrance gates at Lowes Corner Play Area. Installed grass matting at Giles Road Play Area.

Continue to provide and maintain the hanging baskets in the centre of the town.

Illuminated Christmas decorations on the lampposts continue to be appreciated.

Continued maintenance of the play areas at Giles Road, The Green, Lowes Corner, Ramsdell Close, Tadley Common, Aerial Runway, MUGA and Skate Park, including a weekly safety inspection by Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council.

Continued maintenance of gardens in the town: Huntsmoor Road, Whitedown Road, Newchurch Road and Memorial Garden.

Grass cutting all Tadley Town Council owned land.

Continued financial support for Barlows Park.

Continued support for the Youth and Family Worker at The Point.

# Highways & Planning

Responded to over 38 planning applications received.

Continued participation in the Parish Lengthsman scheme.

Made over 60 reports to Highways at Hampshire County Council.

# Finance & General Purposes

Precept set at £216,906 for the year. Equivalent to £50.93 for a band D property. (A slight increase (67p) in the precept, last year a band D property paid £50.26).
