Council Tax

At the Full Council meeting held on 3 January 2023, Tadley Town Council agreed to set the precept at £196,354. This is an increase on last year which was £186,466. This means each band D household in Tadley will pay £46.83 for the services provided by the Town Council in the year 2023/24. Last year a band D property paid £44.95, so an increase of £1.88.

Friends of Tadley Common

This is a new group that has been set up to help tackle the large amount of gorse that is growing on Tadley Common. We are only allowed to cut the gorse back from October to March because of nesting birds. The group is meeting on Saturdays 21 January and 18 February in the car park by the play area in Tadley Common Road at 10.00am. If you would like to help with this mammoth task please go along!

Replacement Skatepark for Tadley

Work continues on the construction of the replacement skatepark and it is hoped this will be complete by the end of February. Unfortunately due to there being 8 objections received to the planning application, the application had to go to Basingstoke & Deane Borough Council's Development Control Committee for determination. This process took several months and resulted in an increased cost of £22428 for the project.
